TEKOAKI-ARAKUÁ are words from the Tupi-Guarani that means:

- TEKOAKU: "way of being warm; state of alert" It refers to what you feel at the exact moments of transformations. It's present in moments such as births, illnesses, initiation processes, among others. It is close to the word "devir" in portuguese or "becoming" in english.
- ARAKUÁ: "maturity: to make it develop, to open up, to emerge" -The Guarani understand that reaching maturity is creating. So, they always value and encourage the creation of new things.
